Work Programme Project Updates  Lt updated the Board with the operational reports from November and December this included the work with the PCN Alignment in Care Homes CS has agreed to share the video that CM has produced. CS is working with 3 common cancers task and finish group. She also updated them on the difficulties that Warrington residents are experiencing getting an NHS dentist during the pandemic. He said that the thresholds are too high and that men with suicidal thoughts are being turned away from A&E. This is also due to the rise in alcohol consumption. CJ to feed this back to Carl Roberts DG has offered to put them in contact.  The Chair has asked for an update on the Peoples Panel, Healthwatch will still be supporting them when Warrington Together finishes in March.
